RESOLVE, Opening Simpson Pond, Washington County, to Ice Fishing.

Simpson pond; opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Simpson pond in Roque Bluffs, Washington county, to ice fishing from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring.
