STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Ell Pond, York County.

Ell pond; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Ell pond in the towns of Sanford and Wells, York county, to ice fishing; and restricting other fishing therein to the ordinary manner of casting with unbaited artificial flies or by trolling with unbaiting artificial flies or lures, with a limit of 5 fish per person per day.
