**RESOLVE, Relating to Ice Fishing in Long Lake and Eagle Lake,
Aroostook County.**

Long lake and Eagle lake; ice fishing regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Long lake in Madawaska, St. Agatha and T. 17, R. 4 and 3; and Eagle lake in T. 16, R. 6 and 16, R. 5, Aroostook county, to ice fishing for salmon, trout and togue on February 1st of each year.
