AN ACT Relating to Settlement of Employees at Pownal State School.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 157-A, additional. Chapter 23 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 157-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 157-A. Settlement of employees at Pownal state school. Any employee living at Pownal state school and receiving rations therefrom shall have their settlement in the respective towns in which they had a legal settlement when their connection with said Pownal state school commenced, so long as such connection continues therewith.'
