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**RESOLVE, Providing for Construction of Dolphins at Maine Maritime Academy.**

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**Maine Maritime Academy; construction of dolphins. Resolved:** That the sum of \$38,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated to the Maine Maritime Academy out of unappropriated surplus for the construction of dolphins to supplement the present wharf for mooring purposes; and be it further

**Resolved:** That the appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In southeast winds and gales the ship at the Maritime Academy is driven against the present wharf, which is valued at about \$50,000. Eventually the pressure of the ship will destroy the wharf unless additional mooring facilities are provided.
