#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for Independent Water Supply at Maine Maritime Academy.

Maine Maritime Academy; independent water supply. Resolved: That the sum of \$20,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated to the Maine Maritime Academy out of unappropriated surplus for establishing an independent water supply for the academy; and be it further

**Resolved:** That the appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The water supply at Castine has been diminishing and the Academy has been using about 1/3 of the town's supply. It is necessary that the water supply for the Academy, being now inadequate, be made an independent one.
