## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Election of Commissioner of Agriculture and State
Auditor by the People.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 16, § 1, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 1 of chapter 16 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 'The state auditor shall be elected by the qualified electors and shall hold office for 2 years from the 1st Wednesday in January next following the election.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 27, § 1, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 1 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 'A commissioner of agriculture, hereinafter in this chapter called the "commissioner" shall be elected by the qualified electors and shall hold office for 2 years from the 1st Wednesday in January next following the election.'
