STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for the Election of all State Officials by the People.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 1, § 37, additional. Chapter 1 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 37, to read as follows:

'Sec. 37. State officials elected. All state officials now elected by the legislature shall hereafter be elected by the qualified voters of the state.'
