AN ACT Relating to Disposition of Liquor Seized by Federal Government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 63, sub-§ IV, additional. Section 63 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered IV, to read as follows:

'IV. The commission may authorize hospitals and state institutions to import for medicinal purposes only liquor made available to them from stocks of liquor seized by the federal government.'
