STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Officers of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 9, § 4, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 4 of chapter 9 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'He (secretary of the senate) shall receive a salary of \$2,500 \$4,000 in full for all official services by him performed during the regular session of the legislature.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 9, § 4, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 4 of chapter 9 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The assistant secretary of the senate shall receive a salary of \$1,500 \$2,400; his work shall be performed under the direction of the secretary.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 9, § 7, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 7 of chapter 9 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'He (clerk of the house of representatives) shall receive a salary of \$3,000 \$4,500 in full for all official services by him performed during the regular session of the legislature and for such additional services provided for in this section.'

Sec. 4. R. S., c. 9, § 7, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 7 of chapter 9 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The assistant clerk of the house shall receive a salary of \$1,500 \$2,400; his work shall be performed under the direction of the clerk.'
