**AN ACT Repealing the Provision that Bells Shall Be Attached to
Foremost Horses on Vehicles Driven on Snow.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 76, repealed. Section 76 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed, as follows:

'Sec. 76. . Bells shall be attached to horse or animal drawn vehicles when snow is on ground. One or more bells shall be either attached to one of the foremost horses drawing vehicles without wheels on snow, or attached to the shafts of the vehicle.'
