STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Permits to Haul Farm Products Over Certain Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 91, amended. Section 91 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 9 of chapter 321 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby further amended by adding after the 1st sentence thereof, a new sentence, to read as follows:

'The state highway commission is authorized to grant permits upon proper application in writing for hauling farm, dairy, horticultural and perishable products from farm to market over the highways specified in the preceding sentence during such periods of each year.'
