RESOLVE, Authorizing State Highway Commission to Study Desirability of a Bridge Across Jonesport Reach from Town of Jonesport to Town of Beals.

Bridge across Jonesport Reach; study authorized. Resolved: That the state highway commission be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make a study of the need and cost of a highway bridge across Jonesport Reach from the town of Jonesport to the town of Beals, in the county of Washington, with necessary highway approaches thereto; and be it further

Resolved: That the commission shall report the results of their study at the next regular session of the legislature.
