RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to Ida M. Fuller of Mount Vernon.

Teacher's pension granted to Ida M. Fuller. Resolved: That Ida M. Fuller, of Mount Vernon, be given credit for an additional $1 \frac{2}{3}$ years of teaching service so that she may be entitled to a retirement benefit under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Ida M. Fuller, of Mount Vernon, has credit for 23 I/3 years teaching service. She is losing her eyesight, and this additional I 2/3 years would entitle her to a retirement pension.
