**RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to Ida M. Fuller of Mount Vernon.**

**Teacher's pension granted to Ida M. Fuller. Resolved:** That Ida M. Fuller, of Mount Vernon, be given credit for an additional  $1 \frac{2}{3}$  years of teaching service so that she may be entitled to a retirement benefit under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

Ida M. Fuller, of Mount Vernon, has credit for  $23 \frac{1}{3}$  years teaching service. She is losing her eyesight, and this additional  $1 \frac{2}{3}$  years would entitle her to a retirement pension.
