STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Death Under Workmen's Compensation Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 26, § 15, amended. The 1st sentence of section 15 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'If death results from the injury, the employer shall pay the dependents of the employee, wholly dependent upon his earnings for support at the time of his accident, a weekly payment equal to 2/3 his average weekly wages, earnings or salary, but not more than \$24 nor less than \$12 a week, from the date of death for a period ending 300 weeks from the date of the accident, and in no case to exceed \$6,000 \$10,000.'
