## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Fees Payable to Registers of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 232, amended. The next to the last paragraph of section 232 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'In all cases where books with printed forms are not furnished therefor, registers of deeds shall receive for receiving, filing and recording any instrument by law entitled to record, the sum of \$2 for the first 500 words, and the sum of 20c for each 100 words or fraction thereof in excess of 500 words, provided however that if recording is done by photographic, photostatic or other mechanical methods as permitted by law the charge shall be \$1 for each record page or fraction of a record page so recorded. If the instrument contains the names of more than 2 parties thereto, other than the husband and wife of the grantor or grantee, an additional fee of 25c each shall be charged for indexing the names of additional grantors or grantees or other parties thereto.'
