STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Amending Law on Ferry Between Beals and Jonesport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1951, c. 135, § 1, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 135 of the private and special laws of 1951 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The town of Beals is authorized to employ such persons as may be necessary for the efficient and safe operation of the ferry or to lease the right to operate the same to any responsible person or persons who shall be legal residents of Beals.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1951, c. 135, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 135 of the private and special laws of 1951 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 5. Operation without authority. Any person who operates a ferry between Beals and Jonesport without authorization of the town of Beals, or who furnishes for hire a boat or other craft for such purposes, forfeits \$4 for each time of transportation, to be recovered by the town of Beals by an action of debt. In addition to such action of debt, the town of Beals may have relief in equity to enjoin any such person.'
