STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in the Allagash River.

Fishing in the Allagash river, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing an open season for fly fishing only on the Allagash river and tributaries, from Allagash Falls to Umsaskis lake, from June 1st to September 30th of each year, excepting Musquacook stream.
