SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 483, L. D. 502, Resolve for Repairs
of Church and Convent at Peter Dana Point
and Old Schoolhouse Used for Religious
Purposes at Princeton.

Amend said Resolve by adding at the end of the 1st line
thereof after the word "from" the words 'the unappropriated
surplus of'.

Further amend said Resolve by striking out the period at
the end thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:
'; and be it further

RESOLVED: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the
unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the state the sum
of \$5,000, to be expended for the purpose of repairing existing
homes and building new homes for the Indians at the several
reservations; these funds to be expended on authorization of the
department of health and welfare.'
