IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Hermon.

Town of Hermon; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$20,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to be expended by the town of Hermon for the construction of a gymnasium for its high school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The school and gymnasium were burned last year. The town is now rebuilding the school. They plan to have a work shop, etc. for manual training and a gymnasium is needed for the physical education of the children of Hermon. Since this is the third time the school has burned, the town is requesting the sum of \$20,000 to aid them in the rebuilding of said school.
