IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT to appropriate Moneys for Additional Expenditures in the Treasury Department for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1953.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves passed by the legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the duties of the treasury department have increased considerably by reason of the sales tax law and other causes; and

Whereas, the funds provided for the operating expenses of the treasury department for the year ending June 30, 1953 are not sufficient to provide the salaries of additional personnel needed for the proper performance of the duties of the treasury department; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for necessary expenditures of government. In order to provide for the necessary expenditures of government for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953, the following sums or as much thereof as shall sev-

erally be found necessary, as designated in the following tabulations, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated.

Department	1952-53
Treasury	\$1,500

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
