RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Milo.

Town of Milo; educational subsidy. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Milo the sum of \$1,532.81 from the general fund of the state for educational subsidy due the town of Milo for the years 1953 and 1954.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The educational subsidy for 1953 and 1954 are computed on the average expenditures for school maintenance for the years 1950 and 1951. In 1950 the town of Milo changed the date of the closing of its fiscal year from January 31st to December 31st and therefore lost 1 month as the basis of its subsidy.
