Hiscock, of Farmingdale, to reimburse her for a retail malt liquor license issued to her late husband, Arthur E. Hiscock, and which license he was able to use only I month.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Arthur E. Hiscock, of 171 Main Avenue, Farmingdale, passed on January 31, 1952. The first of January he had renewed his malt liquor license for 1952. Mrs. Hiscock could not use the license as it was in his name only. She is now asking for reimbursement.
