RESOLVE, in Favor of the Towns of Hartland and Athens.

Towns of Hartland and Athens; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Hartland the sum of \$4,557.60 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954; and the sum of \$1,922.40 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954, in favor of the town of Athens, to aid in the construction of Corson Corner bridge, under the Bridge Act, said bridge being located on route No. 43 between the towns of Hartland and Athens; the above sums to be the towns' share of the cost of construction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state's estimate is that, under the Bridge Act, the towns' share of the cost of reconstruction of Corson Corner bridge will be:
