IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Black Bear.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 97, sub-§ III, repealed and replaced. Subsection III of section 97 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'III. There shall be an annual open season on black bear from November 1st to December 1st, inclusive, in each calendar year in the counties of Androscoggin, Cumberland, Hancock, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Oxford, Sagadahoc, Waldo, Washington and York. All the rest of the calendar year before and after the open season shall be a closed season for the hunting of bears in the territory described in this subsection. There shall be an annual open season beginning the 21st day of October and ending the 30th day of November, both dates inclusive, in the counties of Aroostook, Franklin, Penobscot, Piscataquis and Somerset.'
