**RESOLVE, Relating to Fly Fishing in Certain Waters, Washington
County.**

St. Croix river; opened to fly fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening St. Croix river, and its flowage water, Lewys lake, Big lake and Long lake, Washington county, to fly fishing only during the month of June.
