IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Opening Upper Rang Pond, Androscoggin and Cumberland Counties, to Ice Fishing.

Upper Rang pond; opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Upper Rang pond, in Androscoggin and Cumberland counties, to ice fishing for pickerel and white perch only during the months of January and February with a daily limit of 15 fish or $7\frac{1}{2}$ pounds per person.
