RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing for Smelts in Damariscotta Bay, Lincoln County.

Damariscotta bay; smelt fishing regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to prohibit night fishing for smelts in Damariscotta bay, Lincoln county, from 6 P.M. to 6 A.M. of each day. Any person taking smelts contrary to the provisions of this rule and regulation shall be punished for each offense by a fine of not less than \$10, nor more than \$25.
