STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Register of Deeds, Deputy Register of Deeds and Clerk Hire in Registry Office in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 231, amended. That part of section 231 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the register of deeds of Cumberland county, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Cumberland, \$3,600 \$4,500,'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Cumberland county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$21,000; \$25,000; deputy register of deeds, \$2,675 \$3,200; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$8,500; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$10,104; for clerks in the office of the recorder of the Portland municipal court, \$5,096, and for special clerk hire, \$1,500, said sum of \$1,500 to be available for a period of 2 years only; for clerks in the office of county attorney, \$742; for clerks in the office of sheriff, \$728.'
