STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Tuition at State Normal Schools and Teachers' Colleges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 188, amended. Section 188 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 188. Applicants for admission, qualifications; tuition. Applicants for admission to state normal schools and teachers' colleges shall signify their intention to become teachers. The state board of education shall charge 200 for tuition to non-residents of the state, and 500 for tuition to residents of the state. It may permit not exceeding 10% of the enrolment of residents to pay their tuition charges at such future dates as it may determine.'
