IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Repealing Law on Vehicles Approaching Stationary Street Carl from Rear.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 82, repealed. Section 82 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.
