STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Registration as Voters of Physically Disabled Persons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 3, § 16, amended. Section 16 of chapter 3 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the 8th sentence thereof, a new sentence, to read as follows:

'At least one member of the board shall attend any person, claiming to have the qualifications for voting but who due to physical disability is unable to apply for registration in person, to examine such person for qualifications for voting and, if found to be qualified, shall add the name of such person to the general register.'
