**AN ACT Relating to Entertainment in Licensed Premises.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 57, § 37, amended.** Section 37 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows :

**'No dancing, amusement or entertainment in licensed premises shall be of an improper or objectionable nature. Entertainment consisting of persons of one sex portraying the opposite sex is prohibited.'**
