RESOLVE, in Favor of Clyde W. Tibbetts, of Hampden.

Clyde W. Tibbetts; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$1,580 to be paid to Clyde W. Tibbetts, of Hampden, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for damage to his property by the state highway commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Tibbetts' home was damaged by water. Water flowed upon his land in an unnatural manner as the result of a wrongful obstruction of the state highway drainage ditch which runs in front of the Tibbetts' property on Route No. 9 in Hampden.
