IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting from Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 69-A, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 69-A and to read as follows:

'Sec. 69-A. Hunting from highways prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt on or from any highway.'
