COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 221, L. D. 587, Bill, "An Act

Amend title of said bill by striking out all of the old
title and inserting in place thereof a new title "An Act Removing
Violations by Liquor Law Licensees from Operation of the Criminal
Law."

Further amend said bill by striking out the stricken out word
"~~Any~~" and the underlined word "No" and inserting in place thereof
"Any" in the 12th line of that part designated "Sec. 66."
