## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Liquor Commission Discussions and Decisions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 6, sub-§ XIII-A, additional. Section 6 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered XIII-A, to read as follows:

'XIII-A. In all matters calling for a decision by the commission relating to departure from any established routine or relating to new listings, delistings, changes in merchandising policy, cutting down of purchases, or changes in formula the commissioner shall discuss the same before coming to a decision and the substance of their discussion and decision shall be reduced to writing and a permanent record made of same.'
