**AN ACT Relating to Hours of Sale of Liquor in State Stores.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 57, § 10, amended.** Section 10 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new sentence, before the last sentence thereof, to read as follows :

**'Wherever feasible the commission shall keep state stores open on Saturdays until 10 P. M. and at least one other day in the week until 8 P. M.'**
