STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Delisting and Discontinuance of Purchasing Liquor by the Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 6, sub-§ IV-B, additional. Section 6 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered IV-B, to read as follows:

'IV-B. Before any item listed by the commission is discontinued or delisted or before the commission issues any order to stop purchases of any item listed they shall give the vendor of such items reasonable notice in writing of their intention to so delist or stop purchase of such items together with their reasons for such discontinuance or delisting.'
