STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Liquor Commission Functions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof 2 new sentences, to read as follows:

'The chairman shall direct one member of the commission to take particular responsibility for overseeing the operations of licensing and enforcement, he shall direct the other member to take particular responsibility for overseeing merchandising and personnel. The chairman shall himself be responsible for over-all supervision.'
