RESOLVE, Opening Certain Waters in Sagadahoc County to Ice Fishing.

Certain waters in Sagadahoc county opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Sewell pond in Arrowsic; Lily pond in Bath and West Bath; Houghton pond in West Bath; Blaisdell pond in Phippsburg; Duley pond in Phippsburg and Mose pond in Georgetown; all in the county of Sagadahoc, to ice fishing.
