STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, in Favor of the City of Belfast.

City of Belfast; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the city of Belfast, the sum of \$14,600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954, for the repair and construction of Sheldon bridge on the Poor's Mill road which connects Belfast and Morrill; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The estimated cost of this bridge is \$14,600 as made by the state highway commission. The city of Belfast is willing to use all four of its units of state aid for this project.
