IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Hunting with Bow and Arrow in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 96-A, amended. Section 96-A of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘**Sec. 96-A. Open season.** There shall be an annual open season on deer in the counties of Franklin, ~~and~~ Somerset **and York** from October 1st to October 15th, inclusive, for the purpose of hunting deer with bow and arrow only.’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 33, § 96-B, amended. The 1st sentence of section 96-B of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘An archery license shall be issued by the commissioner to take deer under the provisions of sections 96-A to 96-E, inclusive, the fee for which shall be \$4.25 for hunting deer by residents of this state and \$10.25 for hunting deer by non-residents; **except that in the county of York such archery licenses shall also permit the hunting of such wild birds and animals which can be legally hunted from October 1st to October 15th, inclusive.**’
