## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Disposal of Wild Animals Damaging Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 84-B, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 84-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 84-B. Disposal of wild animals. The owner or driver of every motor vehicle which has been damaged by a protected wild animal or birds shall, within 24 hours thereafter, report the accident to a fish and game warden. The warden shall investigate and, if he finds the damage has been done as alleged, he shall give a certificate to such person entitling such person to the ownership of the carcass.'
