RESOLVE, Opening Big Greenwood Pond, Piscataquis County, to Ice Fishing.

Big Greenwood pond; opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Big Greenwood pond, in the town of Williamatic and Elliottsville plantation, county of Piscataquis county, to ice fishing.
