RESOLVE, Opening Jerry Pond, Penobscot County, to Ice Fishing.

Jerry pond, Penobscot county; open to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Jerry pond, Township 5, Range 7, Penobscot county, to ice fishing for trout, togue and salmon.
