RESOLVE, in Favor of Flying Pond Improvement Association.

Flying Pond Improvement Association; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$1,135.34 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, to be paid to Flying Pond Improvement Association, of Mount Vernon, being ½ of cost of constructing dam and fishway at outlet of Flying pond.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The camp owners located on Flying pond agreed to form an association and pay half of the cost of this dam and fishway. Contributions amounting to \$1,101.50 were made. The Association has had to borrow money from the First National Bank of Gardiner and this resolve in requested to pay the state's share for half the cost.
