STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of a Retirement Allowance for Doris D. Ladd of Hallowell.

Doris D. Ladd; retirement allowance. Resolved: That a retirement allowance be, and hereby is, granted to Doris D. Ladd, of Hallowell, to be paid monthly from the funds of the Maine State Retirement System. Such retirement allowance shall be effective on July 19, 1964 and shall continue during her life. Such retirement allowance shall not be payable unless the said Doris A. Ladd returns to the Maine State Retirement System the sum of \$2,467.97, which had been contributed by Mr. Ladd prior to his death.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Harland A. Ladd, the late husband of Doris D. Ladd, had served the State of Maine some 28 years and 9 months in the educational field and at the time of his death July 19, 1952 was Commissioner of Education. No retirement benefits had accrued to Mr. Ladd at the time of his death under the statutes, and the purpose of this resolve is to provide security payable to Mrs. Ladd upon the anniversary of Mr. Ladd's 60th birthday, based on the amount that she would have received had he lived to retirement age, when he could have selected an option to provide this same amount for his wife.
