**AN ACT Prohibiting the Issuance of Liquor Licenses to Places Selling
Gasoline.**

• Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 22-E, amended. Section 22-E of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 259 of the public laws of 1949, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding after the 3rd sentence thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'No license shall be issued to any person, partnership, association or corporation engaging primarily in the sale of gasoline or otherwise servicing motor vehicles upon or adjoining the premises sought to be licensed.'
